

Clogher Valley Church Trail

Sample the archaeology, heritage and history of the churches of lovely Clogher Valley, County Tyrone on this fascinating Christian Heritage trail.

Start your morning at [Killymaddy Tourist Information Centre 1](#). Enjoy tea or coffee and scones in the restaurant before browsing through the unique selection of wonderful local crafts, including hand thrown pottery and stunning ceramics, stocked in the Craft Centre. Now it's time for an enthralling guided coach tour of the ecclesiastical gems of the Clogher Valley, which include some of Northern Ireland's most fascinating churches. During the tour your guide will provide a wonderful narrative of the history, archaeology and values associated with these distinctive religious and historic sites, all of which have a fascinating story to tell. Highlights of the tour will include visits to Ballinasagart Church of Ireland; St James Parish Church; St Mary's Church; St Macartan's Cathedral and Forth Chapel (also known as St Macartan's Church).

A hearty lunch of the finest local produce will be provided by a member of the Flavour of Tyrone, Good Food Circle. In the afternoon your tour of the historic churches throughout the Clogher Valley will resume. It is recommended you wear appropriate clothing and comfortable walking shoes, as there are short walks to some of the sites.
